Health Guarantee

Serenity Valley Ranch guarantees this puppy for the following conditions:

- 1. If within the first 7 days, the pup receives a certified diagnosis of canine parvovirus infection.
- 2. If within the first 10 days, the pup receives a certified diagnosis of a serious illness.
- 3. If within the first 2 years after purchase by the buyer, the pup receives a document and veterinarian certified diagnosis as having a crippling or debilitating congenital defect, including heart murmur, epilepsy, deafness, blindness, liver, kidney, or hip dysplasia.
- 4. A certified Diagnosis is defined a positive diagnosis by a Veterinary Teaching Hospital, or a State Licensed D.V.M. acceptable to Serenity Valley Ranch personal or suitable veterinarian, at the expense of the owner.
- 5. Take your puppy to the veterinarian within 7 days of purchase date for a proper Health Certification.
- 6. Said puppy is to be spayed/neutered at the expense of the owner. Breeder recommendation for time of spay/neuter is 6 months of age, if dog/bitch is bred, Health Guarantee is null and void.

If one of the above conditions exist, said puppy will be returned to Serenity Valley Ranch for either an exchange of a suitable puppy from another litter, refund of ½ purchase price, or

purchaser agrees to notify Serenity Valley Ranch of new owner, so that the home may be approved. Serenity Valley Ranch agrees to assist in rehoming said puppy should the need arise. If puppy is not certified by a suitable veterinarian or contracts a non-heritable disease while in the care of the owner, contract is null and void.

- Take the current, up to date Worming/Immunization Record with you to the veterinarian so that there will be a record of what has been done to your pup, and so your vet can take you through the next steps.
- All veterinarian bills are the responsibility of the buyer.
- This puppy is being sold as a Companion animal. This puppy is NOT being sold for breeding purposes and is to be spayed/neutered at the appropriate time. Said puppy is sold with a LIMITED REGISTRATION. False full registration, and/or breeding said pup will nullify this agreement and is cause for further legal action at the expense of the buyer.
- I agree to register my puppy with the AKC LIMITED REGISTRATION, and in the additional AKC REUNITE Program (a Lifetime Microchip Reunite Program for your benefit! Your puppy will come with his/her microchip).
- ✓ This Contract, all Health Records, Veterinarian Statements, and ANY AND ALL related paperwork must be provided back to seller, or contract is NULL AND VOID.
- ✓ Proof of Worming/Immunizations/Heartworm and appropriate preventative Health Care must be provided back to seller or contract is NULL AND VOID.
- ✓ I understand that Serenity Valley Ranch has taken all measures possible to assure the best "Development", "Training", and "Socialization" of my puppy, and has started my puppy on "Come", "Follow", "Go Potty", "Crate Training", and "Doggy Door Training", (inasmuch as time allowed, response to behaviors may be inconsistent), but these training behaviors have been only "Started", and that Training will need to be continued with Puppy. (Petco is a great place for continued socialization and further education).
- ✓ I acknowledge that I have not requested further or specialized training.
- ✓ Serenity Valley Ranch will offer advice where we can!!
- ✓ I agree to promptly report any medical/behavioral/training issues with appropriate documentation to seller, and then follow up as necessary with veterinarian/trainer/ or appropriate party immediately, to obtain assistance.
- ✓ Shipping is to be coordinated with seller, and Expenses, Crate (with food and water dish), Health Certificates, and Shipping is to be paid by buyer.

Treats for "come", "follow", "sit", "go potty", "down", leash training, crate training, and follow up with an appropriate Training and Socialization Program.

"Puppies provided with poor socialization or deprived of environmental exposure often develops lifelong deficits and dysfunctional behaviors. A puppy isolated early in life from other puppies and humans will not only fail to establish satisfying social contact with cospecies or enjoy companionship with people later in life (such puppies are extremely fearful of any social contact), they will also exhibit widespread behavioral and cognitive disabilities as well. Isolated puppies exhibit poor learning and problem-solving abilities and are extremely hyperactive or rigidly inhibited, are emotionally over-reactive and unable to encounter novel social or environmental situations without extreme fear and avoidance, and are socially and sexually incapacitated."
